New Classes

So what do you do once you feel confident with the steps from our Beginner and Improver classes? Why you move on up to the next level of course!

On a Wednesday night we will be starting up an Improvers Level 2 class, a Ballroom and Latin American Technique class and an Intermediate class. The night will end with a 45 minute practice session (10.15pm-11.00pm).

All the classes are £7.50 per person and the practice session is £2.50 per person (you do not have to attend the classes to come to the practice session). If you attend more than one class on the night then you will receive a £2.50 discount off each additional class (i.e. each additional class becomes £5).

The Improvers Level 2 class (7.30pm-8.15pm) is for those that have completed and mastered our Beginner classes, and have started our Improver classes but want a few more steps. As a reference all classes up to Improver cover 'Bronze' level steps.

The Technique class (8.30pm-9.15pm) is open to all levels. This class looks at the general technique that is required in the Ballroom and Latin American dance styles and is essential in taking your dancing to the next stage.

The Intermediate class (9.30pm-10.15pm) is for those that are ready to expand their routines with more complicated figures. It is still recommended that you attend at least the Improver Level 2 classes if you have not completely mastered the 'Bronze' level steps. Intermediate level is the equivalent of 'Silver'.

The classes will commence on Wednesday 27th January. Please check the calendar on our website as these classes will not run in our usual 6-week pattern and there may be week's where there is no Wednesday dancing even whilst our other classes are still running (though the classes will take place until February 17th).

Practice Nights

We will be holding our practice nights on the middle and end Friday's of the month. The evenings run from 8.30pm-11pm and you can bring your own refreshments. The cost of the practice session is £6 per person (£5 if paid for in advance). Whilst we recommend you bring a partner, it is not essential.
